

# COVID Status Certification

## Answers to some questions you may have

### Why have I received this certificate now?

The Government of Jersey's vaccination programme has sent you this certificate because you have received a full course (two doses) of the COVID-19 vaccine. Other countries within the Common Travel Area are producing similar secure certificates, and the format is aligned to UK and EU security standards.

### When and where might I need this certificate?

A COVID Status Certificate may be requested by other countries for several reasons, including entry at the border. This will depend on the rules being applied at the time, and you may be asked to show this certificate when you travel abroad.

### Make sure you:

- check the entry requirements for your destination country on the GOV.UK foreign travel advice pages
- get up-to-date information from the website of your destination country

### Certificate security

Your COVID Status Certificate provides you with secure, official evidence of full vaccination. The security features within the certificate mean that it cannot be reproduced.

### What should I do if I lose my certificate?

This certificate is important. Keep it safe. It proves you have been fully vaccinated against COVID-19. If you lose it, you can call the Coronavirus Helpline on 0800 735 5566.

### Is there a digital alternative?

A digital solution to allow international verification of the COVID Status Certification is in development. In the meantime, the original paper certificate is the only form of secure evidence of vaccination. A photocopy or photograph of a certificate cannot be used due to the embedded security features.

### Why is the administering centre listed as Fort Regent?

Fort Regent is the organisational centre of the Jersey COVID-19 Vaccination Programme, and administers all vaccinations given in Jersey in any setting, including the COVID-19 Vaccination Centre, care homes/agencies, home visits, community charities, pop-up clinics and other vaccination settings.

### Different names used for COVID-19 vaccines

Each of the vaccines given in Jersey have different vaccine product and manufacturer names throughout the EU:

- Pfizer/BioNTech – this is also known as Comirnaty® and is manufactured by Biontech Manufacturing GmbH
- AstraZeneca – this is also known as Vaxzevria® and is manufactured by AstraZeneca AB
- Moderna – this is also known as COVID 19 Vaccine Moderna® and is manufactured by Moderna Biotech Spain S.L.
